RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Cumberland.

Town of Cumberland; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to the town of Cumberland for plans and construction of an addition to the high school (Greely Institute) the sum of \$20,000; and be it further

Resolved: That this amount be taken from any funds now or hereafter available from any source whatever; including federal sources which are especially assigned for school purposes within the state of Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The school population in the town of Cumberland has increased beyond any possible anticipation because of the war. This has resulted in an emergency as to the high school facilities.

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
