STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize the Maine Aeronautics Commission to Match Federal Airport Funds in Conjunction With Municipalities to Construct Airports Within the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 21, § 2-A, additional. Chapter 21 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 2-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Expenditures to match federal funds for construction or repair of airports. The Maine aeronautics commission is hereby authorized and empowered, upon the approval of the governor and council, to expend from the aeronautical funds necessary sums of money to match muncipal or federal funds for the construction or repair of airports within the state of Maine, said state expenditures to be limited to the sum of \$3,000 per municipality and per project.

If the aeronautical fund is not sufficient to meet the requirements under the above proposition, the governor and council are authorized to expend from the state surplus necessary sums needed but not to exceed the sum of \$150,000 per year for the next 2 years.'
