Fox & Ginn, Inc.; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Fox & Ginn, Inc., the sum of \$394 from the general highway fund for reimbursement of tolls paid by Fox & Ginn, Inc., to the Piscataquis Exchange Hotel, Greenville Junction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The bridge at Greenville Junction is too low to permit the trucks of Fox & Ginn, Inc., to pass under and it is necessary for the corporation to use the yard of the Piscataquis Exchange Hotel in order for their trucks to continue. This resolve is to reimburse the corporation for tolls which they have paid.
