STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Designating Certain Funds of the Maine Post War Public Works Reserve for a Classroom and Library Building at Farmington State Teachers' College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for Farmington State Teachers' College. There is hereby appropriated from the Maine Post War Public Works Reserve the sum of \$250,000, to be expended by the commissioner of education and the trustees of the state teachers' colleges for the purpose of constructing a library and classroom building at the Farmington State Teachers' college. The governor and council are authorized to make such expenditure at such time as will be most advantageous.
