RESOLVE, in Favor of George P. Duffy, of Benedicta.

George P. Duffy; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$175 to be paid to George P. Duffy, of Benedicta, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage by bears to 4 acres of oats and barley; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The damage to the 4 acres of oats and barley done by bears was inspected by Game Warden Scribner Patten and the selectmen of Benedicta.
