RESOLVE, in Favor of Irving I. Bates, of Moro.

Irving I. Bates; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$269.38 to be paid to Irving I. Bates, of Moro, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage by bears to camp, equipment and supplies; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The camp and equipment, with supplies, were located on 9 R 8 Aroostook County, on Mooseleuk stream. The damage by bears amounted to \$269.38.
