IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Bounty on Bobcat, Loupcervier and Canada Lynx.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 102, amended. The 1st sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 102 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~There~~ **For a period of 2 years, there** shall be a bounty of ~~\$15~~ **\$20** for every bobcat, loupcervier and Canada lynx which is killed within the state, to be paid by the treasurer of state to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
