RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Maude E. Hamilton, of Saco.

Maude E. Hamilton; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Maude E. Hamilton, of Saco, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1947 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Maude E. Hamilton served from 1912 to 1917 as parole officer for the State School for Girls. From 1917 to 1940 she was Executive Secretary for the York County Children's Aid Society. During these years she received a small salary. She is now 80 years of age, a widow, in ill health, and has no relatives able to assist her. She has had financial losses and sickness and is in need of assistance.
