RESOLVE, Providing for an Additional State Pension for George H. Babb, of Augusta.

George H. Babb; additional state pension. Resolved: That an additional pension of \$10 per week be, and hereby is, granted to George H. Babb, of Augusta. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1947, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A pension of \$13 per week was granted in 1941 by Council Order to George H. Babb, of Augusta, who was formerly employed in the department of agriculture.
