RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Charles Frost, of Augusta.

Charles Frost; state pension. Resolved: That Charles Frost, of Augusta, in the county of Kennebec, shall be, and hereby is, granted a pension of \$70 per month, to be paid out of the "Employees' Contributory Retirement System Fund". Said pension shall begin on July 1, 1947, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Charles Frost, of Augusta, had to his credit 21 years, 9 months and 19 days of service for the state when the pension system of the state was changed over. An employee of the Augusta State Hospital, he has a bad heart trouble and wishes to be allowed to be retired.
