STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Eligibility of Certain Clubs for Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 1, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 1 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'; except that any veterans' organization in the state having a charter from a national veterans' organization shall be exempt from the 2 year requirement providing it has been established for not less than 3 months.'
