#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting the Sale in Wholesale Lots of Gasoline on a Temperature Correction Basis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 173-A, additional. Chapter 88 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 173-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 173-A. Sale of gasoline in wholesale quantities on a temperature correction basis prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or offer for sale gasoline in wholesale quantities where such quantities are measured on a temperature correction basis.'
