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**RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to James L. Walker of Oxford.**

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**James L. Walker; pension for. Resolved:** That a pension of \$33.29 per month be, and hereby is, granted to James L. Walker, of Oxford, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1947 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Walker went to work as a state fish and game warden on November 1, 1928. He resigned May 14, 1943 at the age of 56 because of ill health.
