IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Eugene H. Stevens of Norway.

Eugene H. Stevens; pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$17.50 per week be, and hereby is, granted to Eugene H. Stevens, of Norway, to be paid weekly from the State Police Appropriation No. 9023. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1947 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Stevens was employed by the state police from June 6, 1922 to August 15, 1942, a period of 20 years. He is now 56 years of age and is no longer employed by the state police. It is requested that he receive a pension of \$17.50 per week.
