IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Fishing for Salmon in Pleasant River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Salmon fishing in Pleasant river; regulated. The taking of salmon in Pleasant river and its tributaries in the county of Washington is prohibited, except that they may be taken therefrom with unweighted fly hook and line and such hook shall not be larger than No. 4.
