AN ACT Relating to Aid to Dependent Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 230, amended. The last sentence of section 230 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The amount of aid which shall be granted for any dependent child shall be determined with due regard to the resources and necessary expenditures of the family and the conditions existing in each case and shall be sufficient, when added to all other income and support available to the child, to provide such child with a reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health **within the limits of appropriations made available by the legislature.**’
