RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Trenton.

Town of Trenton; reallocation of unexpended appropriation. Resolved: That the unexpended balance of \$621.53, remainder of the appropriation for the town of Trenton under chapter 67 of the Resolves of 1943, and which was reallocated to assist in repairing the Deasy road under chapter 115 of the Resolves of 1945, shall be further reallocated to assist in repairing the Gray road, so called.
