STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Registration of Motor Trucks and Basis Therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 19, § 15, sub-§ VI, amended. The 1st paragraph of subsection VI of section 15 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'In computations under the provisions of this section minor fractions of horse-power and weight shall carry the lower rating, and major fractions shall carry the next higher rating.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 19, § 15, sub-§ VI, amended. The 5th paragraph of subsection VI of section 15 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'In computation of fees for a combination of truck tractor and semitrailer, the vehicle to be registered for earrying capacity gross weight shall be the truck tractor which shall take the same rating as a truck of similar eapacity gross weight; provided, however, that no motor vehicle of either a single unit or combined unit shall be operated on the highway with a load that exceeds 40,000 pounds, gross weight of vehicle and load.' Sec. 3. R. S., c. 19, § 18, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 18 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'With each application for registration of a motor truck, shall be deposited **paid** an annual registration fee graduated as follows when equipped with pneumatic tires:

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Sec. 4. R. S., c. 19, § 18, amended. The last sentence of the 3rd para-

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graph of section 18 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Provided further, that no trucks truck shall be registered for less than the actual weight of the vehicle in pounds plus the manufacturer's rated load capacity.'

Sec. 5. R. S., c. 19, § 18-A, additional. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 18-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 18-A. "Gross weight" defined. "Gross weight" as used in sections 15, 18 and 27 shall mean the actual empty weight in pounds of the vehicle to be registered plus the maximum weight of the load to be carried by such vehicle.'

Sec. 6. R. S., c. 19, § 27, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 27 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person shall operate, or cause to be operated, any truck, tractor, trailer, or combination of truck tractor and semi-trailer, with a load that is more than 20% 10% above that specified in the registration certificate for such vehicle for trucks of capacity gross weight of not over 4 tons 15,000 pounds and 5% for trucks of gross weight of over 15,000 pounds; 10% for trucks of eapacity of not over 6 tons; and 5% for trucks of eapacity of over 6 tons; and 5% for trucks of eapacity of over 6 tons.'

Sec. 7. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective on January 1, 1948.
