AN ACT Authorizing Towns to Expend Money on Cottage Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 80, § 91, amended. Section 91 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 40 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'When the inhabitants of any town at its annual meeting, under an article inserted in its town warrant, vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of maintaining a cottage road, and the designation of this cottage road appears in the article either by name or location, then the municipal officers of said town shall be authorized to expend this sum of money on the cottage road designated.'
