RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Kewayden Lake in the Town of Stoneham in the County of Oxford.

Providing for a fish screen at outlet of Kewayden lake in the town of Stoneham in the county of Oxford. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the legislative appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Kewayden lake in the town of Stoneham in the county of Oxford, the balance necessary to complete this screen to be furnished in labor and materials by the inhabitants of the town of Stoneham. The screen to be kept free and clean of all debris at all times by the town of Stoneham.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lake has been stocked with a large quantity of salmon and due to the lack of a screen at the outlet, most of these salmon escape down stream.
