IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Establishing a School for Nursing Attendants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 184-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 184-A, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 184-A. School for nursing attendants. The vocational education board is hereby authorized to establish and maintain schools for nursing attendants. Such schools and courses of study shall be subject to the provisions of section 4 of chapter 63-A of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 265 of the public laws of 1945.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$42,000 for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1948 and June 30, 1949, to finance the schools herein provided for.
