# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Hunting and Trapping Seasons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 97, sub-§ I, amended. The 3rd and 4th paragraphs of subsection I of section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an open season on muskrats in the counties of Franklin, Hancock, Kennebee Penobscot (except as prohibited in section 90), Piscataquis, Somerset and Oxford from November 17th to November 30th and from April 10th to April 25th, inclusive; Kennebec and Washington from April 1st to the following May 10th April 30th, inclusive, in each calendar year.

There shall be an open season on muskrats in the county of Aroostook from November 17th to November 30th and from April 15th 26th to the following May 15th, inclusive, in each calendar year.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 97, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 5th paragraph thereof, a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Muskrats shall be taken only by the use of steel traps or shooting.'

Sec. 3. Limitation. The above open seasons during the month of November shall be in effect for 2 years only.
