AN ACT Relating to Aid to the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 284, amended. Section 284 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘**Sec. 284. Granting of aid.** Upon the completion of the investigation, the department shall decide whether or not the applicant is eligible for aid under the provisions of sections 275 to 293, inclusive, and determine the amount of such aid if any is allowed, and the date on which it shall begin. The department shall notify the applicant of its decision. Aid granted, if any, shall be paid ~~monthly~~ **semimonthly** to the applicant.’
