STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold G. Wyman of Pittston.

Harold G. Wyman; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$62 to be paid to Harold G. Wyman, of Pittston, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for pullets killed by raccoon; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This loss to Mr. Wyman occurred on June 28, 1945. The claim is as follows:

31 pullets @ \$2 \$62.

The damage was investigated by the town constable and two members of the board of selectmen.
