#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for Capital Expenditures for School Buildings for Town of Limestone.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, a military airport is to be constructed in the town of Limestone by the federal government; and

Whereas, this construction will mean a great influx of people into the town of Limestone, both those who will construct the airport and military personnel; and

Whereas, the school facilities of the town of Limestone are inadequate and it will be necessary for the town of Limestone to construct additional school buildings in order to care for the education of the children of those people who will move to Limestone because of such construction; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. "Town of Limestone Reserve Account," established. There is hereby established an account to be known as the "Town of Limestone

Reserve Account" for which there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$200,000 from the general fund of the state and shall be available for capital expenditures for a school building or buildings in the town of Limestone.

Sec. 2. Governor and council to approve expenditures. The governor and council shall approve allotments from the "Town of Limestone Reserve Account" for such capital expenditures, up to the amount available in said account, whenever the need for such expenditures arises because of any emergency that may be created by the building of a military airport by the federal government in the town of Limestone.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
