AN ACT Relating to Width of Trucks Hauling Forest Products.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 85, amended. The 1st sentence of section 85 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No motor vehicle or trailer which, with or without load, is wider than 96 inches over all shall be operated upon any way or bridge; except that motor vehicles or trailers hauling firewood, pulpwood, logs, or bolts may be operated on any way or bridge if the width of the load does not exceed 102 inches.'
