STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of E. E. Webber, of Rockland.

E. E. Webber, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$81.66 from the general fund of the state to be paid to E. E. Webber, of Rockland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On November 12, 1946, in the town of Castine, Mr. Webber's car, which was driven by Wendell E. Webber, was damaged considerably when it collided with a deer. Game Warden Harold E. Sinclair investigated the accident. The damage is as follows: Right fender smashed, both headlights broken; right door sprung; slight damage to hood grille and bumper.
