RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Hebron.

Town of Hebron; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Hebron, the sum of \$5000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, for the construction and repair of the road leading from state aid road No. 2 at Western Maine Sanatorium to 3rd class road at Eastern Hebron station; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road is badly in need of repair. It is the only direct road from Hebron to the sanatorium. It serves the sanatorium, farmers, R. F. D., and orchardists besides the people living on this road. The valuation of the town has decreased because the property in the town was bought by the sanatorium and Hebron academy.
