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**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for a Dam on the Marsh River.**

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**Dam on Marsh river; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, to be used by the county of Waldo, the town of Winterport and the town of Frankfort to complete the construction of the dam at West Winterport on the Marsh river to protect 3 bridges on said river from damage by ice jams, namely: Tibbetts bridge at West Winterport (a 75-ft. steel bridge on a state aid highway), a 200-ft. cement bridge in Frankfort on Highway #1 and a steel bridge in Frankfort near the mouth of the river; said sum shall be taken from the general highway fund and expended under the inspection and supervision of the state highway commission.
