## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Members of Police Department for City of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1905, c. 348, § 1, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 1 of chapter 348 of the private and special laws of 1905, as amended by chapter 25 of the private and special laws of 1921, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'A pension is hereby provided for, to be paid by the city of Bangor to the following members of the police department of said city, said pension to be equal at any given time, to one half the regular pay at that time received by patrolmen in said department; all pension payments made under the provisions of this section to be automatically increased or diminished in amount by increases or reductions in the daily pay allowed by the city council to regular patrolmen in said department to ½ of the pay which such members received at the time of their retirement.'
