AN ACT Relating to Regulations for Atlantic Sea Run Salmon in
Penobscot Bay Area.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 53-A, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 53-A of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'Provided, however, that no regulation shall be made by the commission affecting the Penobscot river, Penobscot bay and its immediate tributaries which shall allow fly or hand line fishing in one section and restrict or prohibit weir fishing in another section of the above designated waters.'
