STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide the Time for Filing Monthly Reports Relating to the Use Fuel Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 175, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 175 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 31 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'For the purpose of determining the amount of tax herein imposed, each user shall, not later than the #5th 20th day of each calendar month, file with the state tax assessor on forms prescribed by said state tax assessor, monthly reports which shall include the total gallonage of fuels used within within this state during the next preceding calendar month.'
