STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Charles Boyce of Cumberland Mills.

Mrs. Charles Boyce, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,544.01 to be paid to Mrs. Charles Boyce, of Cumberland Mills; said sum being the amount paid by Charles Boyce into the Maine teachers' retirement system; said sum to be paid from the funds of the employees' retirement system.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Charles Boyce of Westbrook received about \$300 as service disability retirement allowance. Upon his death \$1,544.01, which was money paid by Mr. Boyce into the Maine teachers' retirement system, reverted to the general funds of the retirement system under law and thus not available to his widow.
