**RESOLVE, Providing for Certain Improvement in the Property of the
Maine Port Authority.**

Maine Port Authority; appropriation. Resolved: That the sum of \$400,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated out of the unappropriated surplus of the general fund for the enlargement and improvement of the facilities of the Maine Port Authority in Portland; and be it further

Resolved: That the funds hereby appropriated shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until such time as the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Maine Port Authority requires enlarged facilities on its property at Portland to service properly the water-borne commerce in Portland Harbor. Additional storage facilities provided for by this resolve will increase by 30% the storage capacity at the facility.
