AN ACT Relating to Citizenship to Hold Office.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 3, § 3-A, additional. Chapter 3 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 3-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 3-A. State officers and employees to be citizens. All state officers and employees shall be citizens of the United States of America.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 11, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 11 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by repealing the last sentence thereof.
