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AN ACT Relating to the Use of Electrolysis in Beauty Culture.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 208, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 208 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The use of electrolysis for the removal of hairs is prohibited, except as provided in section 210.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 210, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 210 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'III. Registered nurses, or persons with at least 2 years' training in the use of the electrolysis needle.'
