STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Travel Reimbursement for Members of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 9, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 362 of the public laws of 1943, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Each member of the senate and house of representatives shall receive \$850 for the regular session of the legislature, and shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$2 \$1 for every 10 miles' travel from his place of abode once each week in each session.'
