STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Clerk of Courts in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in the office of the clerk of courts in Kennebec county, as amended by chapter 209 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$2,200 \$2,500;'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1949.
