IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Age Requirement for Old Age Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 261, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 261 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'I. Is 65 60 years of age or more;'
