AN ACT to Require Stop Lights on School Buses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 9, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 9 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All school buses as defined in this section shall be equipped with a fire extinguisher of a type and size approved by the laboratories of the National Board of Fire Underwriters. **In addition to other lights required by law on each such bus, its rear shall be equipped with a stop light of a type approved by the secretary of state. Such light shall be clearly displayed whenever the bus stops to receive or discharge its passengers.'**
