## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Power of Corporations Without Capital Stock to Hold Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 50, § 5, amended. The 1st sentence of section 5 of chapter 50 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every corporation organized under the provisions of the preceding sections may take and hold by purchase, gift, devise or bequest, personal or real estate, in all not exceeding in value \$700,000, owned at any one time, and may use and dispose thereof only for the purposes for which the corporation was organized.'
