STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Inheritance Taxes on Life Insurance Policies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 142, § 2, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 2 of chapter 142 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'II. All proceeds of life insurance policies upon the life of a decedent payable to his estate or to his executors or administrators except, if testate, such parts thereof as is bequeathed to a widow, or widower, or issue, or, if intestate, such part thereof as descends under the provisions of section 27 of chapter 156.'
