AN ACT Relating to Interstate Transportation of Lobsters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 116, amended. Section 116 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

‘All lobster fishermen are hereby entitled to transport their own catches of lobsters beyond the limits of the state of Maine without being required to procure from the commissioner an interstate transportation license therefor; and all persons purchasing lobsters for their own consumption are hereby exempt from the requirement of this section to procure such an interstate transportation license.’
