STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Publishing Delinquent Corporate Franchise Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 107, amended. The last sentence of section 107 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 42 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'If any corporation so advertised shall fail to pay all franchise taxes due the state for such year, and \$3 for the expenses of advertising the same, on or before the 1st day of December following, the state tax assessor shall so certify to the secretary of state who shall suspend its charter, and such corporation shall have no right to use the same.'
