STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to State Owned Delinquent Tax Lands Account.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 14, § 77-C, amended. The next to last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 77-C of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 9 of chapter 41 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The state controller shall cause the county taxes to be paid as a charge charged against an account to be known as "State Owned Delinquent Tax Lands" and to be financed from such sums as may be appropriated by the legislature to such account.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 14, § 77-C, amended. The next to last paragraph of section 77-C of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 9 of chapter 41 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'All moneys received from the use of such lands shall be credited to the general fund and such profit or loss as may occur from the sale of such lands shall be credited to or charged against the general funds.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Under section 77-C, chapter 41, Public Laws of 1945, the State Controller shall cause the county, State Forestry District taxes and interest to be paid and charged to this account but does not make any funds available.

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
