SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 121, L.D. 142, Bill "An Act
Relating to Fees of Deputy Sheriffs."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of that part designated "XXXV11" before the period thereof, the following underlined words: ';except that deputy sheriffs who are considered regularly employed and full time deputies shall receive \$7 a day for services rendered under the provisions of this subsection'.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of that part designated "XXXV111" before the period thereof, the following underlined words: ';except that deputy sheriffs who are considered regularly employed and full time deputies shall receive \$7 a day for services rendered under the provisions of this subsection'.
