SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 124, L. D. 145, Bill "An Act Relating to  
the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause thereof,  
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, licenses for taking, catching or  
killing Atlantic Sea Run Salmon were originally designed for funds for  
the restoration of the Atlantic sea run salmon; and

Whereas, such funds have proved to be totally inadequate; and

Whereas, such licenses being an addition to other angling lic-  
enses and are therefore unfair and place an unnecessary burden on the  
people of the state of Maine; and

Whereas, the provisions for such licenses should be repealed;  
and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create  
an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of the state of  
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary  
for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, the fol-  
lowing:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the pre-  
amble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
