STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Old Age Assistance and Aid to the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 257, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 257 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 394 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'All assistance granted under said sections shall be paid semi-monthly monthly by the state.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 284, amended. The last sentence of section 284 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 353 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Aid granted, if any, shall be paid semi-monthly monthly to the applicant.'

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective October 1, 1949.
