STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Limiting Hunting of Wild Animals or Birds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 82-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 82-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 82-A. Hunting of wild animals or birds, limited. No person who lawfully kills and registers a deer shall hunt, kill or have in his possession any wild animal or bird during the remainder of any open season on deer.'
