HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 486, L. D. 161, Bill "An Act to Incorporate the Town of South Thomaston School District."

Amend said Bill by striking out the entire Emergency preamble thereof.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the whole of section 9 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 9. Referendum; effective date. This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of the legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the town of South Thomaston at any regular or special meeting called and held for the purpose not later than 1 year after the effective date of this act. Such special meeting shall be called, advertised and conducted according to the law relating to municipal elections; provided, however, that the selectmen of the town of South Thomaston shall not be required to prepare for posting or the town clerk to post a new list of voters, and for the purpose of registration of voters, said selectmen shall be in session 2 hours next preceding such meeting. The town clerk shall prepare the required ballots, on which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the act to Incorporate the Town of South Thomaston School District be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed over the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall take effect immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters, voting at said meeting. The result in said district shall be declared by the municipal officers of the town of South Thomaston and due certificate thereof filed by the town clerk with the secretary of state.'
